

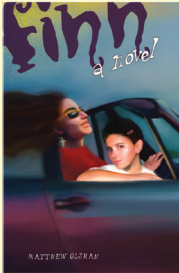

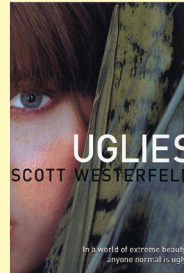
Text and audiobook titles for each component of the Gradual-Release-of-Responsibility Model

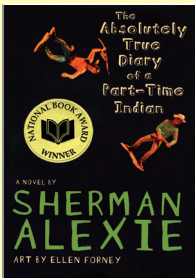

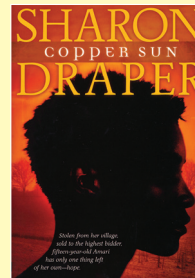

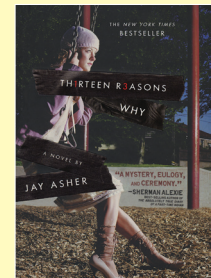
