

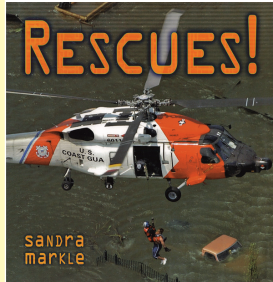

**Teacher-directed Instruction** is embedded in whole-class shared reading of a core text, with guided practice.

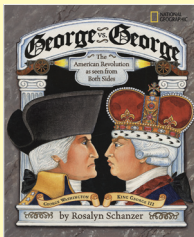
